

RESOLUTION 22-04 RESOLUTION OF THE DEER SPRINGS FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT ESTABLISHING THE STANDBY/AVAILABILITY CHARGE FOR FISCAL YEAR 2022-2023

- WHEREAS, The Board of Directors of the Deer Springs Fire Protection District was authorized, by November 1981 property owner ballot approval, to establish a Standby/Availability Charge; and
- **WHEREAS**, The maximum Standby/Availability charge may be increased by the consumer price index (CPI) of San Diego County and the CPI did increase from 305.823 to 325.241 from 2nd Half 2020 to 2nd Half 2021; and
- WHEREAS, The Standby/Availability Charge assessment for fiscal year 2021-2022 was \$17.77 per benefit unit; and the maximum Standby/Availability charge for fiscal year 2021-2022 is \$18.07, and for fiscal year 2022-2023 is \$18.90; and
- **WHEREAS**, This CPI increase results in a Standby/Availability Charge for F/Y 2022-2023 (from 07/01/2020 to 06/30/2021) as set forth below:

January 2021 to January 2022 CONSUMER PRICE INDEX:

2nd. Half 2021 325.241 2nd. Half 2020 -<u>305.823</u>

19.418/305.823 = 0.0635*17.77 = 1.128 + 17.77 = \$18.90

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Directors of the Deer Springs Fire Protection District does hereby establish the Standby/Availability charge for fiscal year 2022-2023 at \$18.90 per benefit unit.
