

## **RESOLUTION 22-08**

## RESOLUTION OF THE DEER SPRINGS FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT AUTHORITY FOR PARTICIPATION IN COUNTY OF SAN DIEGO NEIGHBORHOOD REINVESTMENT PROGRAM

- WHEREAS, the County of San Diego Neighborhood Reinvestment Program provides funding for non-profit corporations and public agencies for certain specified purposes; and
- **WHEREAS**, the Fire Protection District Law of 1987 established that fire protection districts have the responsibility to provide for public health, safety, and welfare; and
- **WHEREAS**, the Fire Protection District Law of 1987 also established that fire protection districts have the power to provide fire protection services and any other service relating to the protection of lives and property; and
- **WHEREAS**, the Deer Springs Fire Protection District operates under the authorities granted by the Fire Protection District Law of 1987; and
- WHEREAS, the Deer Springs Fire Protection District desires to file an application with the County of San Diego for Neighborhood Reinvestment Program funding to increase community resiliency within the Deer Springs Fire Protection District and in support of our regional partners;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Board of Directors of the Deer Springs Fire Protection District

- 1. Confirms that is the Deer Springs Fire Protection Districts is a public agency under the laws of the State of California; and
- 2. Approves the filing of an application with the County of San Diego for Neighborhood Reinvestment Program funding during each County fiscal year; and
- 3. Grant funds shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by the District; and
- Certifies that the District has or will have sufficient funds to operate and maintain the project; and
- 5. Certifies that the funds under the jurisdiction of the District are available to begin the project; and

6. Appoints and grants authority to the President of the Board of Directors, or a designee, to conduct all negotiations, execute and submit all documents including, but not limited to applications, agreements, amendments, payments requests, and other materials which may be necessary for the completion of the aforementioned project with the County of San Diego.
